

Standing Female Nude

The poem "Standing Female Nude" by Carol Ann Duffy is written from the point of view of a male model. The poem describes a day in the life of the disenchanted model, which clearly shows that she finds her profession unenjoyable. The word there is before all though it is evident that towards the end of the poem the poem becomes more light-hearted. The grammar used in the poem is about contemporary writing in the form of a character of a very modernistic model.

The model begins by informing the reader that she feels unappreciated for the work that she does. "This seems like the first time for me." "Some like to show the opening lines of the play we are left an impression of her emotions for the job, and we are left wondering whether this depressing attitude will continue. Her opening point of view is plain, yet it leaves an impression of why she has chosen a job that she is not happy about.

We gain great insight into the nature of her character in the next line. "Helply subtle eye in the window light." The sentence helps as it underlines that her revealing job leaves her feeling exposed to the public, whose all can see her through the "window light." Using language such as "help" describes her overwhelming impression that she does not feel like a womanly body and is of a very lower-class background.

This is also a good example of imagery in the poem as it is easy to imagine her been overwhelmed while she sits naked while being gazed. Our feelings of her feelings of being exposed are confirmed when she calls herself a "non-window." This implies that she is a prostitute and she believes that because she is a prostitute that people will "use" and make a fun of her in the painting.

"They call it art," strongly suggests that even though some people appreciate the work of the artist, that she does not consider it to be art, just merely a profession. "He drinks the colour from me," suggests that the artist is taking away her vitality and essence, and she is left sitting there and her face white as paper.

In the second paragraph we learn that the relationship between the artist and his model is very distant, that he is only concerned with "colours, and space." While the model is more concerned about her feeling of being exposed, and how she would affect her next meal. The way that the artist refers to her is plain about he refers to her as "blonde" although it is ironic and the way in which he says that she is becoming (because) must be something for the model.

Her mind is in turmoil and she makes posing for the artist leads her to become the focus. When posing, she has an image of the space looking at her period and calling her "stage floor" and then moving on. She laughs, because she
